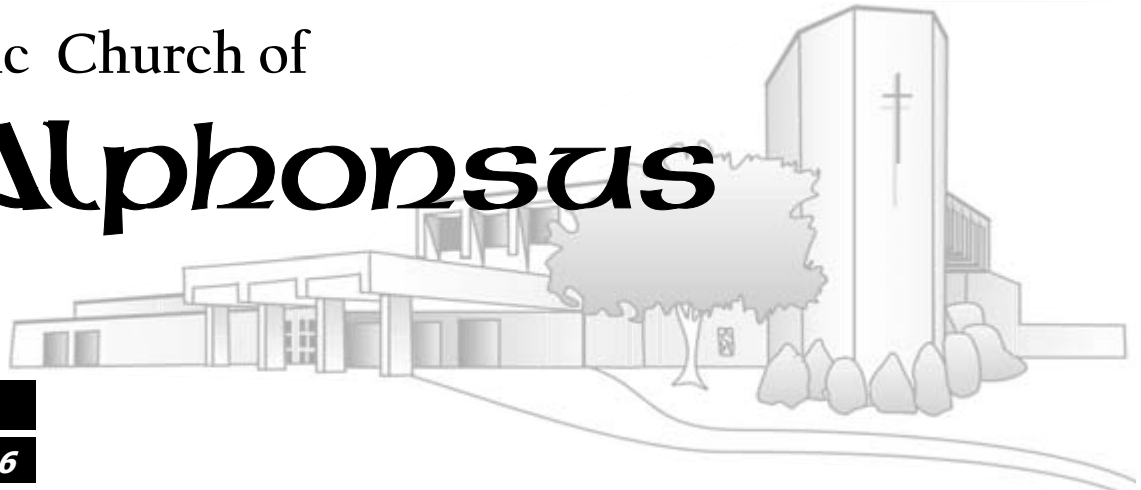

From the Pastor's Desk

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This is the last weekend to get your St. Patrick's Sweepstakes Raffle tickets. Only 300 tickets are printed at \$100.00 each. So, go in together with some friends or family members and get a ticket. All proceeds go towards reducing our Debt. The winning tickets will be drawn at 8:30 PM during the dance on Saturday night, March 13 in the gym. You do not need to be present to win. Notice that we have more prizes for the Sweepstakes this year: top prize is \$5,000, 2nd prize is \$3,000, 3rd prize is \$2,000, and 4th -7th prizes are \$500, \$300, \$300, and \$200. Thanks to all who have made contributions or pledges to the Catholic Services Appeal. There is still plenty of time to make your contribution to the Appeal which funds so many of the Archdiocesan programs. Remember that 25% of what St. Al's collects is refunded back to the parish.

Thanks for your tremendous generosity to the Haitian relief fund as well. I believe the parish donated almost if not more than \$10,000 to help the poor people of Haiti. This is a wonderful testimony of your generosity. God bless you all!

And thanks to all who have made contributions to the Pohlad matching grant for our Parish School. We are close to meeting the \$11,000 mark to get the matching funds. But please do not stop there. Continue to use the envelopes for School Tuition Assistance as well as Faith Formation Assistance as these funds directly touch our children who are in either of these programs. Providing a Catholic education for our children is one of the best things we can give them for their future.

Lastly, do not forget the spiritual nature of Lent. I encourage us to keep it simple: choose only one particular area of your life that you need conversion this Lent. It may be deepening your prayer life or letting go of a destructive habit or performing an act of kindness. Stay focused on one discipline and grow closer to Christ each day.

Dear Parish Community,

Recently we have been exploring the possibility of adding a pre- kindergarten or pre-school program to our school offerings. A survey was conducted to test the interest in our parish for offering such a program. While we did get some responses it is a challenge to draw meaningful conclusions on whether a sufficient number of parishioners would be interested in such a program. Without getting too specific at this early stage we are thinking about a three day - three and a half hour morning program aimed at 4 to 5 year olds. We are also considering an option for lunch and day care in the afternoon hours. This in effect offers working families a full day of child education and supervision as an alternative to traditional day care alone. If you have interests in such a program please leave your contact information with the office or school and we will keep you informed of our progress.
