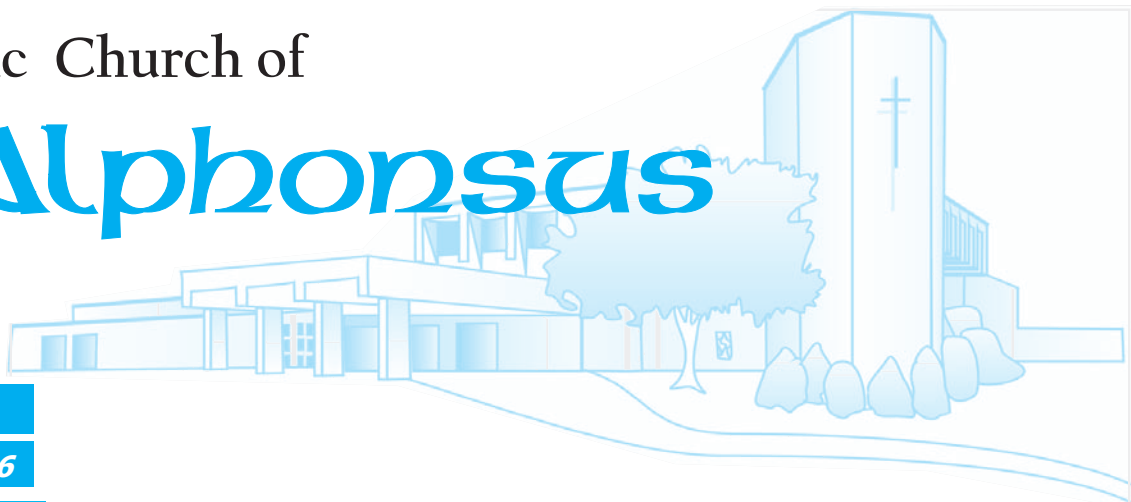

*As a Christian community, we seek to welcome all individuals and families to grow in faith and express it.*

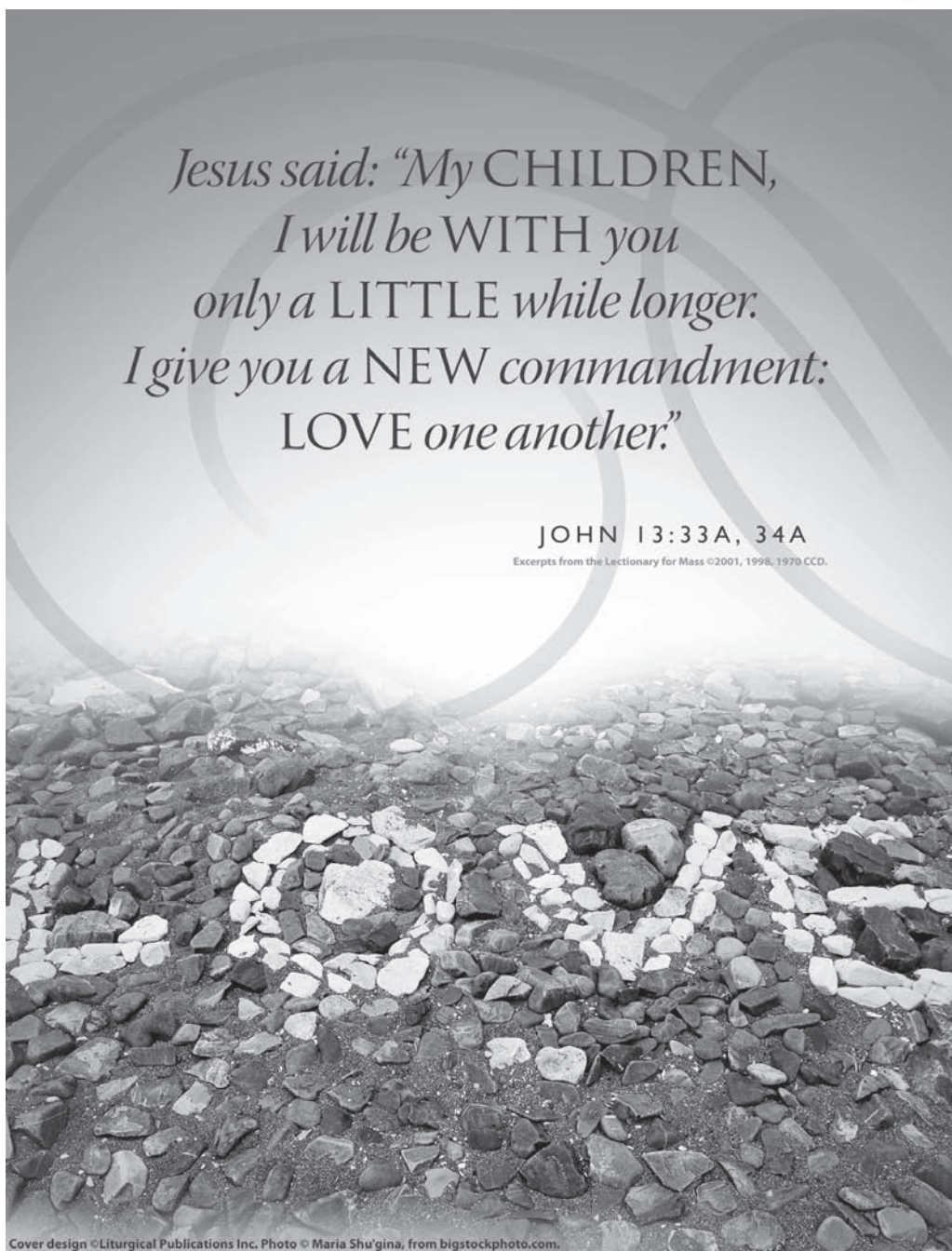
*We affirm Christ's presence in all people and value service, giving, worship, and education in all forms.*

**From the Pastor's Desk**

Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

We have received a very gracious thank you from CEAP. During the calendar year 2009, St. Alphonsus parishioners were very generous to CEAP (Community Emergency Assistance Program) This parish donated \$27,302.04 and 3,908 pounds of food. In addition, a number of parishioners are long-term, dedicated volunteers in the food shelf, Meals-on-Wheels, Clothes Closet and seasonal programs.

Some of our newer parishioners may not know that CEAP is very special to this parish in that it was established by a parishioner, Madeleine Roche, and this was the first location. The original CEAP used the "old rectory" (current Faith Formation/Business Offices). It is now supported by most of the churches in the Brooklyn Park and Brooklyn Center area. CEAP has established a branch in Blaine in Anoka County and recently opened a food shelf location in Champlin.

While the parish supports CEAP, CEAP is helping our parishioners, too. In addition to the programs mentioned, CEAP has Senior Services, Back-to-School, low-interest car loans for low wage workers, and social workers who can help direct people to government services or other programs. Thank you for using the CEAP envelope in your monthly packet.

**Pohlad Family Grant**

It is time to update you on the Pohlad Family Grant. The campaign officially completed on Easter Sunday. We are pleased to announce that we received 142 separate donations, ranging from \$1 to several thousand dollars to bring the total amount to @24,038.00. Approximately \$17,000.00 of this goes directly to tuition assistance for families in need of financial help. The other portion of the donations were earmarked for special requests of the individual donors—the largest amount (\$6500.00) for Third Base (after school care) space remodeling and computer upgrades for Third Base. We are also pleased to let you know that the Pohlad Family Grant Foundation has sent us a check in the amount of \$22,479.00—all of which goes to tuition assistance.

We are extremely grateful to everyone who donated to help make this grant such a great success. It was most gratifying to see how many different people stepped forward to help St. Alphonsus Parish School.

Dear Parish Community,

Unfortunately not all people surrounding you at Mass have the same good intentions as you and most other parishioners. Some are there with the worst of intentions and are looking for you to leave your purse or other valuables unattended. Recently a parishioner had her billfold stolen out of her purse and the thieves showed great skill at diverting attention from the act. I recommend that if at all possible don't bring your purse to church. If you do remember that your purse even beside you is vulnerable to theft when you stand up, kneel and go forward for communion. Just as important is the need for all of us to be watchful to what is going on around us. If you see suspicious behavior or someone whose actions don't fit the scene report it to an usher or call 911. We take no comfort from learning that other churches across the Twin Cities are seeing a rise in this type of crime.
