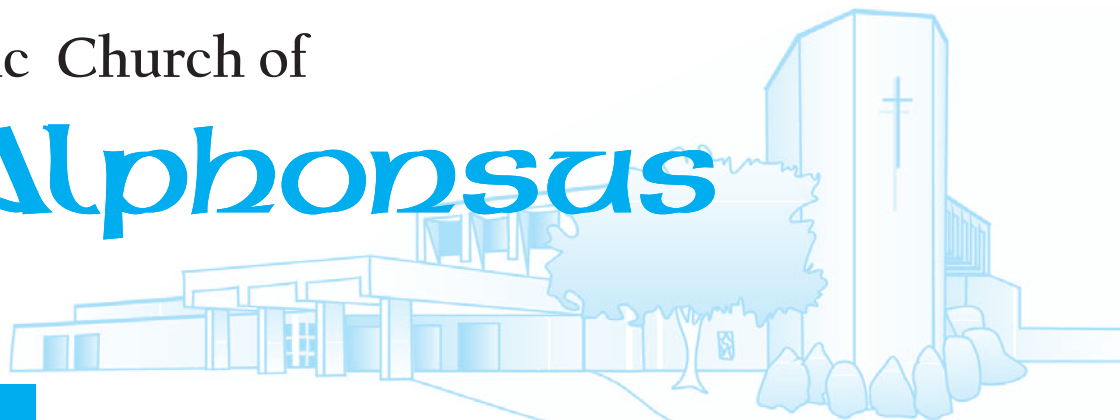

As a Christian community, we seek to welcome all individuals and families to grow in faith and express it.

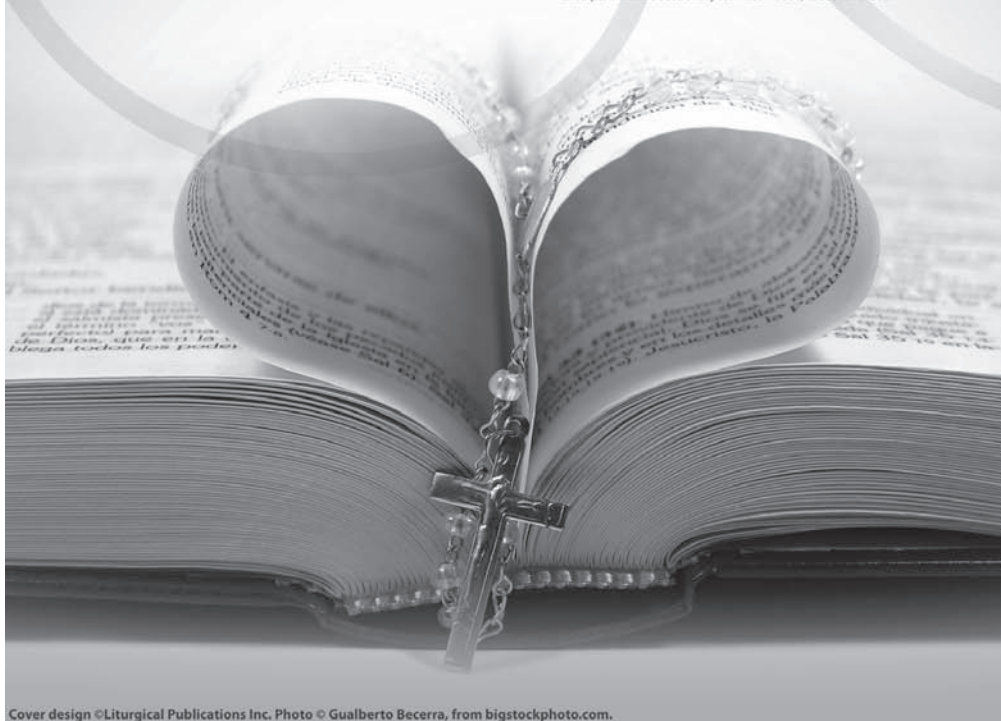
We affirm Christ's presence in all people and value service, giving, worship, and education in all forms.

Dear Parish Community,

Two medical emergencies during Mass in recent weeks points up the problems that improper parking by parishioners could cause for emergency vehicles needing access. Great care went into planning our parking lots to insure maximum parking spaces while at the same time providing adequate emergency access for ambulances, police and fire fighting equipment.
