*St. Alphonsus is a Roman Catholic Community providing a spiritual home for people of diverse ages, ethnicity and economic status.*

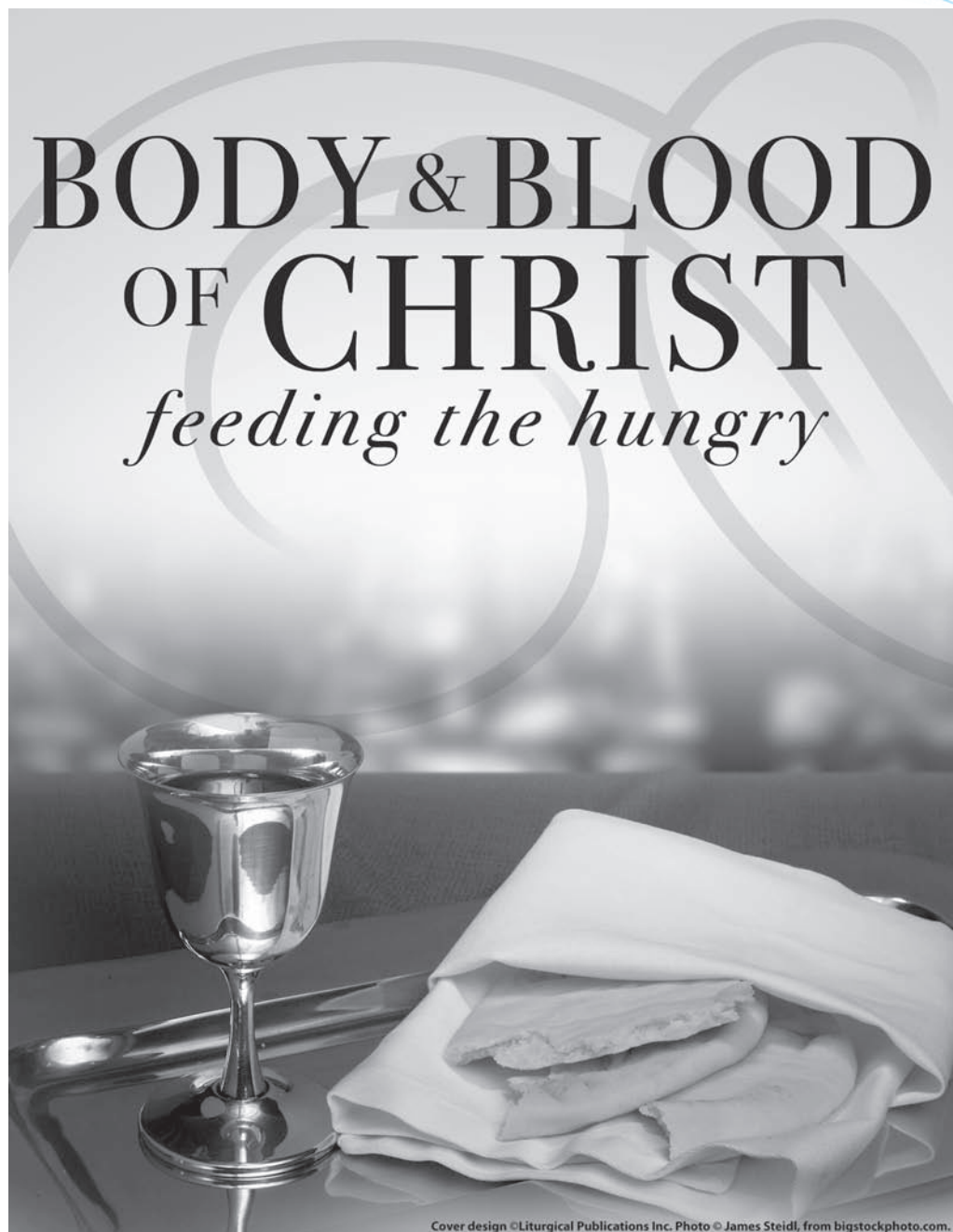

**From the Pastor's Desk**

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In our envelope packets for this month is one titled "Global Solidarity Sunday." This collection provides resources for four initiatives designated by the US Catholic Bishops: a) Catholic Relief Services; b) Aid to the Church in Central and Eastern Europe; c) Church in Latin America; d) Solidarity with Church in Africa. There are many needs throughout the world and right here in the United States and even here in our own parish. But we are a universal church and so we must do what we can to help those less fortunate than ourselves. Thank you and God bless you!

I also want to thank parishioners for their continued generosity towards the Debt Reduction collections. These extra collections help us meet our monthly loan payment of \$9, 299.00. Every penny helps!

The economy is slowly recovering, so "they" say. Many of our fellow parishioners are still not employed and need assistance. Our Parish "Sharing Fund" helps provide assistance particularly for food. I do not want any of our parishioners lacking this basic necessity of life. A percentage of our Sunday collections go into the Sharing Fund to be used for the poor and the needy of our parish. Sometimes those who most need help are reluctant to ask for assistance. If you are aware of a parishioner in dire need, contact me here at the rectory and I will do what I can to assist them.

We have many young people who would like to receive a Catholic School education but their families can not afford the tuition. The Pohlad matching Grant appeal earlier in the year provided much needed assistance. But the need is ongoing. I encourage parishioners to use the "Tuition Assistance" envelope as well as the "Faith Formation" assistance envelopes. Enrollment in our Parish School has been declining each year basically due to financial reasons. In this climate of "Catholic bashing" and "politically correct" endeavors, I believe we need Catholic Schools more than ever. And we can not be schools just for those who can pay the full tuition. *Our Catholic way of life has always provided for those less fortunate. Our parish "Mission" as well as that of the Redemptorists is to reach out to the poor and the most abandoned.* We must provide the means for as many children as possible to attend our Parish School and Faith Formation Programs. Please consider using these special envelopes on a regular basis. Thank you for your generosity!

Pray for all our children and for all your fellow parishioners this week!

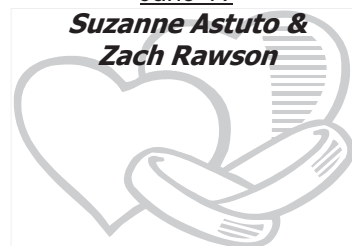
