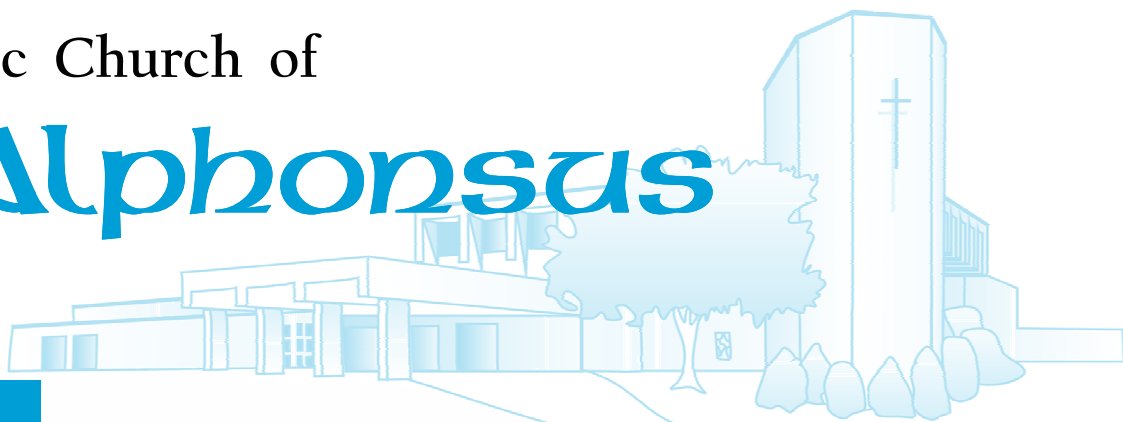

On Sunday, August 1, the feast day of St. Alphonsus Liguori, founder of the Redemptorists, we will be offering a special blessing through his intercession for those suffering from arthritis and other serious physical ailments.

The blessings will be offered after each Mass, and prayer cards distributed.

There will be a short prayer after every Mass to ask the intercession of St. Alphonsus, who himself suffered from severe rheumatoid arthritis that left him permanently bent forward and wheel-chair bound. After the general prayer, individual blessings, with the relic of St. Alphonsus, will be offered to anyone who wishes.

Feel free to invite anyone you know who suffers from such a disease and may wish to come for this blessing. All of our parishioners are welcome, as are members of other parishes and denominations.
