Fiscal Yearend 09-10**

Your debt reduction contributions were \$108,311 for the period July 1, 2009 through June, 2010. Our loan payments (7/1/09 – 6/30/10), Principal = \$43,071, Interest = \$ 68,512, Total =\$111,583. The Loan Balance as of June 30, 2010 is \$1,112,775. The March Sweepstake Raffle net \$12,410, extra principal loan payment in April 2010.

This 20 year term loan is with Knights of Columbus at an interest rate of 5.98%. The monthly loan payment of \$9,299 is made with your Debt Reduction envelopes. Any contributions above the loan obligation will be used to pay down additional principal.
