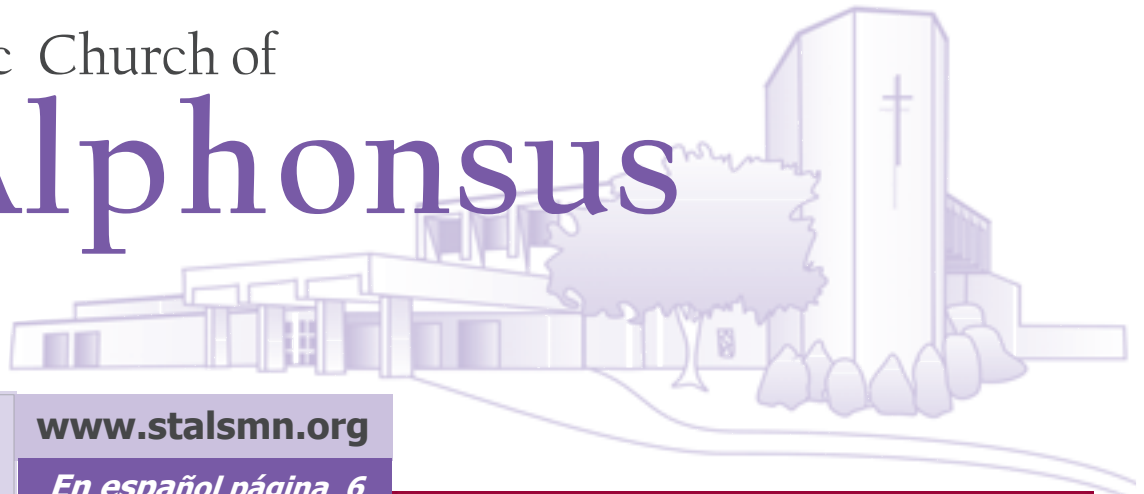

Dear Parish Community,

To quote Will Rogers, "an economist's guess is liable to be as good as anybody else's". At a recent meeting of archdiocese parish administrators we discussed challenges our Catholic community's face during these difficult financial times. Nobody can say with certainty what will be the depth and length of the current recession. A quick survey of the administrator's indicated that 40% of parishes are projecting budget shortfalls. At the same time fixed costs such as debt payment, insurance, utilities, assessments and certain salaries and benefits are required just to keep the doors open. In the coming months I as well as other parish leaders doing our best to keep you apprised of the state of your parish.
