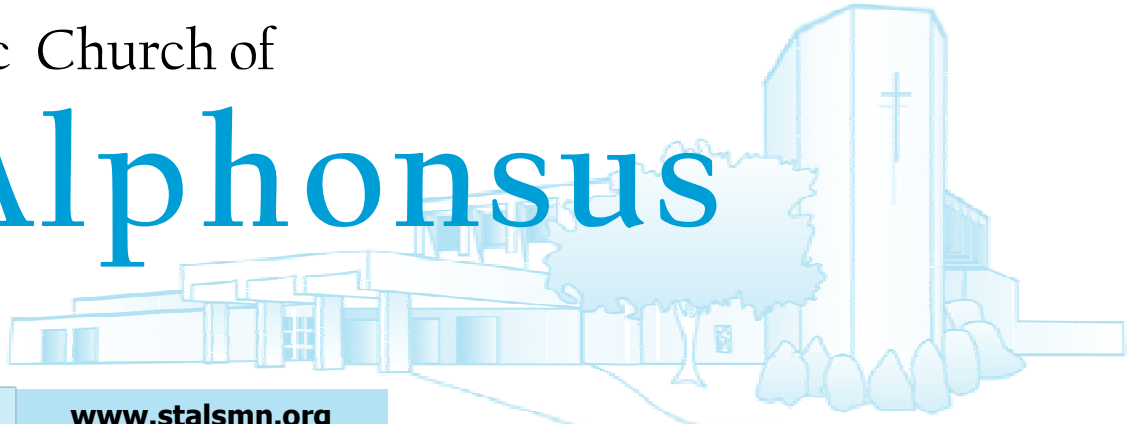

The members of the Parish Health Ministry have some concerns about the Greeting and Sign of Peace at Mass.

- If you have an acute upper respiratory infection (a bad cold) and you are coughing or sneezing, or
- If you have a compromised immune system due to an illness, or chemotherapy or other treatments, or
- If you are just not comfortable shaking hands during flu season or
- If handshakes are painful due to arthritis...

It is our recommendation that you fold your hands in a prayer-like gesture and bow to the person next to you with a verbal expression of greeting or Peace.
