From the Pastor's Desk

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Around this time you will receive in the mail the 2010 Catholic Services Appeal information. The Catholic Services Appeal is the main source of support for many of the Archdiocesan agencies. These agencies provide for the physical, educational and spiritual needs of the people of the Archdiocese. The theme for the Appeal this year is "We Are One Body in Christ." It is a reminder that we all share in the many ministries of the Archdiocese. No single person can do what many helping hands can accomplish together. The attached flyer to the bulletin this weekend highlights the many ministries and services of the Archdiocese that the Appeal supports. I encourage you to read the flyer carefully and then prayerfully decide your contribution to the Appeal. The goal given to St. Alphonsus Parish for the Appeal is \$80,000.00. We do what we can with the resources that we have. Remember that 25% of what we do collect for the Appeal is returned to St. Al's. On behalf of Archbishop Nienstedt I thank you for your generous support of the 2010 Catholic Services Appeal.

Our St. Pat's Dance will be Saturday, March 13, 2010. This is always a fun family night. Along with the dance we have our St. Pat's Debt Reduction Raffle. We print 300 tickets only at \$100.00 each ticket. All proceeds go towards principal payments on the debt. This saves us a significant amount of interest payments. Gather some friends and go in together to buy a ticket. Tickets will be available soon.

The letter in last week's bulletin from Mr. Terry informed us of the Pohlad family grant and what we need to do to obtain these funds. In our envelope packet there is a "St. Alphonsus School Tuition Assistance" envelope. This would be an easy way to make a donation to the school realizing that your contribution will be doubled by the Pohlad grant. We need to raise \$11,240.00 by Easter (April 4th) in order to get the matching sum of \$22,479.00. Dear Parish Community,

A 200% financial return rate sounds like a fantasy or scam especially in these times. This however is exactly the opportunity presented to our parish school under terms of the recent Pohlada family grant for Catholic education that you heard about last Sunday. For every dollar raised by our school between now and Easter the Pohlada family will grant our parish school \$2. The school's fund raising goal to maximize its potential share is \$11,240. This will be matched two to one by the Pohlada family yielding \$33,720. These funds will go far to close the gap in the budget of our school and further our parish and the Redemptorists mission for Catholic education. Now more than ever our school needs our help. Your monthly contribution packet contains an envelope for school tuition. Please consider supporting the school during this critical fundraising effort.
