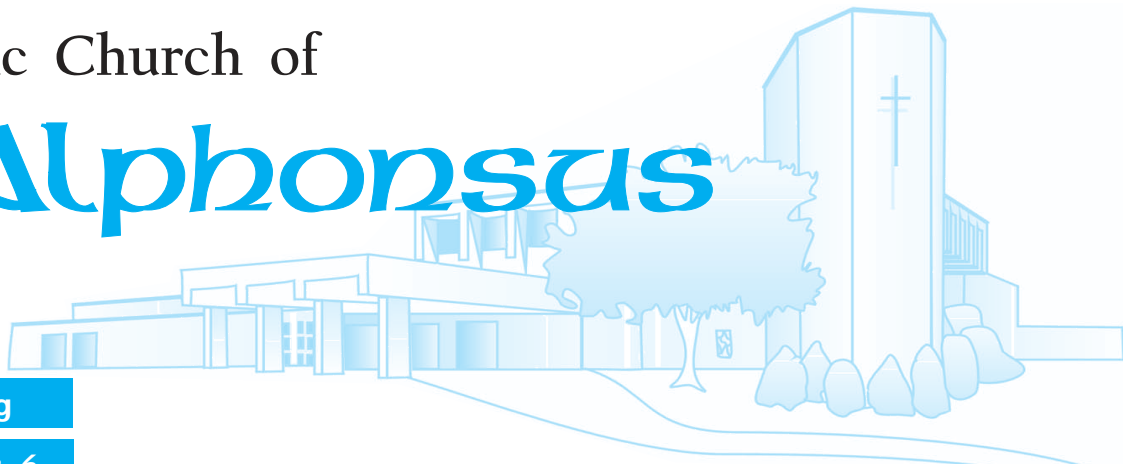

Dear Parish Community,

At the end of each budget year on July first we take stock of how we finished up the year. As I previously wrote this last year we were faced with several new expenses as well as increased costs in many areas. It appears we will finish the last fiscal year with a modest surplus. For this we are most thankful. When we do have a surplus we add funds to parish reserves in the same way your household saves for shortfalls and unexpected costs in the future. As I look about our facilities I see many places where work is needed but also must balance unforeseen emergency repairs and expenses. One only need look at the state of the carpeting in the CSSR Hall to see that sometimes optional expenses get delayed far too long. As we head into the fall stewardship campaign keep in mind that the parish not only needs your support for its regular operating expenses but also to build reserves to handle maintenance and repairs that often get overlooked or delayed by more pressing demands of our community. Parishioners occasionally say "tell us what you need" and I encourage you to look around and tell me what we all need.
